Mikeva expands operations by acquiring Kutoutumiskoti Harjula in Mäntsälä

Mikeva Ltd's year 2015 of strong growth has started with several service home openings and continues through the acquisition of Kuntoutumiskoti Harjula Ltd in Mäntsälä, which will pursue its operations as a 100% subsidiary of Mikeva. We have few acquisitions in process and we are opening in total 17 new service homes during this year." says Mikeva CEO Petri Pitkäranta.

Mikeva has operations in over 60 municipalities in 94 service homes throughout Finland. The total capacity of operations is more than 2 000 customer beds and rehabilitation places.
